Achieved Results:

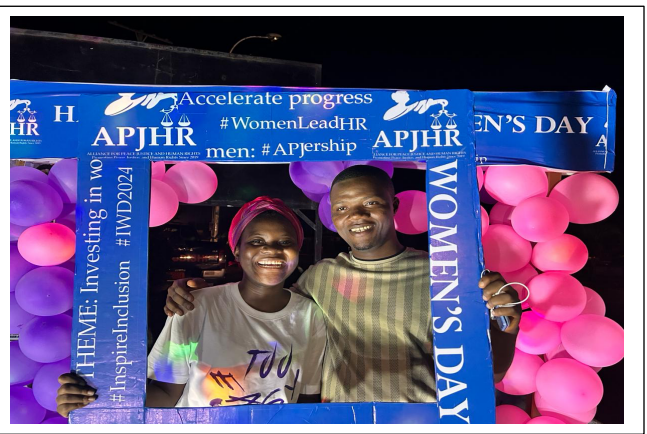

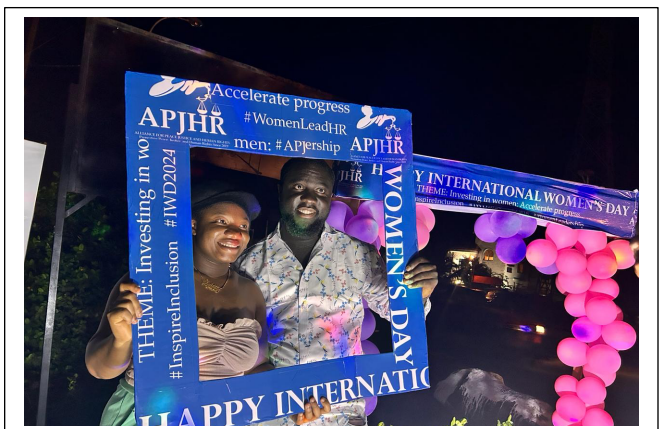
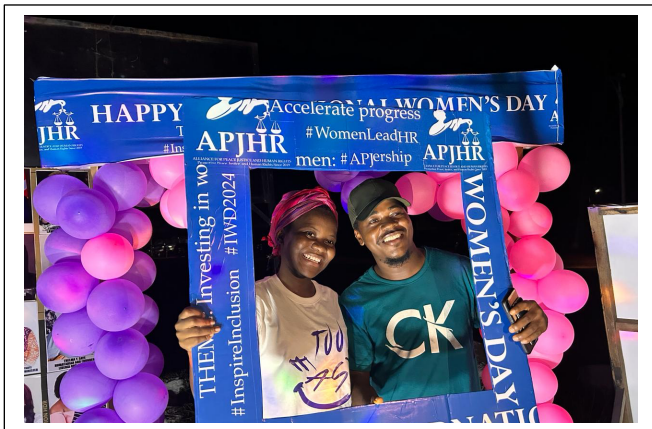




Figure 3: The above photos were taken during the networking event in commensuration of the IWD 2024
